
Pear Witch

Ingredients

Fresh green pear - makes 2 heads and noses

2 raisins - eyes

1 chocolate chip - wart

Red apple - mouth

Canned chocolate frosting

Oreo ice-cream cone - hat

Large, soft chocolate cookie (Archway Dutch Cocoa Cookie) - hat brim

Carrot - hair

Procedure

Cut the pear in half lengthwise and remove the core. Place 1 pear half on a plate as shown. Slice a piece off the top of the pear, cutting away from the forehead at an angle. Shape that piece into a nose; carve a notch into the witch's face to hold it, and set it in place. Attach the eyes and wart by carving small circles in the face to hold them. Cut a grin from the red apple. Carve out an area on the face to hold the grin, and put it in place. To make the hat, use frosting to glue the cone to the cookie. Let the frosting harden a bit, then place the hat on the head. Grate lengths of carrot hair and tuck them underneath the hat. **Marcella's Note:** Use a medium sized pear - mine was too big for the ice cream cone.
